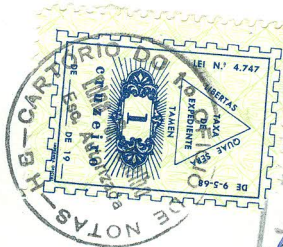
Your application for extension of temporary stay has been DENIED. It will be necessary for you to depart from the United States not later than
